Support Payment in Response to Surging Energy and Food Prices
(For households exempted from FY 2022 municipal tax)

In response to the financial burden of surging energy and food prices, a support payment of 50,000 yen will be provided for households exempted from FY 2022 municipal tax (*jumin-zei*) and households with financially equivalent situation.

1. Who are eligible?

Heads of households registered as a resident of Tsukuba City as of September 30, 2022, and whose household members are all exempted from FY 2022 municipal tax (per capita portion of the tax).

Note: Households consisting of only a dependent member(s) of a taxable family member or relative are not eligible for the support payment.

2. Payment amount

50,000 JPY per household

3. Application process

1) Please find a confirmation form stating requirements for the Support Payment in Response to Surging Energy and Food Prices, and fill it in. (See the next page regarding how to fill in.)

① Check the bank name, branch name, account number, account holder's name and other information indicated in the confirmation form enclosed are correct.

② Read the eligibility requirements and tick the two boxes if you meet both requirements. If you do NOT wish to receive the payment, please tick the other box stating that you do not wish to receive the payment.

③ Fill in your (the head of a household's) name, date of filling in and the phone number.

④ If you wish the payment to be made to a bank account other than the pre-filled bank account, fill in the account details and paste a copy of a document which clearly shows the bank name, branch name, account number and account holder's name such as a bankbook or cash card, as well as a copy of your (the head of a household's) ID such as a residence card, driver's license, passport, and My Number card.

⑤ If someone other than the head of a household is filling in the form, the person must also fill in the back of the form and paste a copy of his/her ID. The head of the household also must sign in the signature section on the back.

2) Send the confirmation form back to Tsukuba City Hall

Please send the completed confirmation form back to the City Hall by post using the return envelope enclosed along with a copy of your (the head of a household's) ID and/or a document clearly showing the bank account details if required.

4. Payment method

In principle, the support payment will be made to the designated bank account indicated on the top of the confirmation form.
