

Guide to sorting and putting out garbage

Put out your garbage by 8 a.m. on the day of collection.

Business waste cannot be put out at the collection point.

Oversized garbage

Maximum side is more than 50cm and less than 2m.(Items with a maximum side of more than 2m or more than 70kg cannot be collected.)

Garbage that needs to be disposed to places other than the collection point.


- Items subject to the Home Appliance Recycling Law
