Bring health insurance card, seal, bank booklet, Income Certificate (Taxation Certificate), Mother and Child Handbook (if expectant or nursing mother) and apply within a month from the day of moving in. Besides, there is an income limitation for each recipient category. Also there may be other documents necessary. For further information, please contact the Medical Welfare and Pension Division, Medical Welfare Services Section.	
Children Services Division		2.3	Recipient of Child Allowance	Please apply within 15 days counting from the next day of your scheduled date for moving out. The applicant's health insurance card, bank booklet, seal, Income Certificate, etc. will be necessary to apply.

(It may be finished depending on the time of the year.)
