From October 2019

Free childcare at early childhood education is to start

Target person and upper limit

3 to 5 years old children... Free up to 37,000 yen per month 0 to 2 years old... Free up to 42,000 yen per month (only for resident tax-exempt households)

* However, only those who are not able to use licensed childcare centres, certified child-care centres,

or company-led childcare are eligible.

* Guardians will be responsible for school drop-off and pick-up, food, and event expenses as before.

Basic procedure

After using non-licensed childcare facilities, you will be able to receive a refund of the fee by submitting a billing document to the city.

* <u>Be sure to keep a receipt</u> to receive the refund after use.

Target facilities

<u>Non-licensed childcare facilities that has submitted notification to authorities such as</u> <u>prefectural government, etc.</u>

(General non-licensed childcare facilities, local government's own certified childcare facilities, babysitters, non-licensed childcare centres in establishments, etc.)

- In addition to non-authorized childcare facilities, <u>temporary daycare</u>, <u>sickchildcare</u>, <u>and family</u> <u>support centre</u> are also eligible for free childcare.
- * Infant classrooms that have not been reported as non-authorized childcare facilities are not eligible for free childcare.
- * Non-licensed childcare facilities that are eligible for free childcare should apply the municipality, and must meet the standards established by the country. However, <u>a facility that does not meet the standards now has a five-year grace period to meet the standards.</u>

Necessary procedure in advance

Those who apply for a licensed daycare..... Pre-procedure is unnecessary

Those who have not applied for a licensed daycare ... <u>Submission of application for accreditation</u> is <u>required</u>

• You need to submit accreditation application to the city and receive accreditation of the need for childcare.

• There are conditions such as parents are working, for authorization of the need for childcare.
