

About the Use of Azuma-Nishi Children's Center (*Jidokan*)

- What 's Children's Center (*Jidokan*)?

Children's Center aims to support healthy development of children both physically and mentally by providing spaces to play and interact with each other.

Children's Center operates after-school childcare clubs and support parents/as a part of guardian's community organization activities.

- Rules for using Azuma-Nishi Children's Center

- ★ Who can use Azuma-Nishi Children's Center?

Under 18 years old children and their parents/guardians.

Basically, before they come to the Children's Center, children should go home once after school.

Pre-school children must be accompanied by a parent/guardian.

- ★ Opening hours

Weekdays: From 8:30am (8am during school holidays) to 6pm

Weekend, Public Holidays and New Year Holidays (from December 29 to January 3): Closed

(Except 2nd Saturday every month, we are open between 8:30am to 12pm)

※For safety reason, children should be dismissed from the Children's Center alone in daylight at 5pm (4:30pm in winter), unless their parents come and pick them up.

- ★ Please submit "Children's Center Registration Form" every school year so that we can contact you in case of emergency.

- Events and Activities at the Children's Center

Children's Center holds various activities and events. Please refer to our monthly "*Jidokan Dayori* (Newsletter from the Children's Center)" for the details of events, etc. You can pick a hard copy at the counter of the Children's Center.

Please note that events open to the public may have a set of application deadline, maximum capacity, and participation fee. If you wish to join, please come directly to the Children's Center. Reservations cannot be made by phone. Applications for each activity may be closed when the maximum number of capacities has been filled.

List of Events

Event Organized by the Children's Center

Seasonal events, a spinning top performance test, unicycle performance test, Kendama performance test, challenge events, etc.

Sports Club (dodgeball)

Events Organized by Volunteers

Science club (Omoshiro fusigi jikkenntai), handicraft club (for children of the third grade only) and Go (igo)club.

- When joining Children's Center, please remember to do the following things.
 - Tell your parents/ guardians when you come to play at the Children's Center.
 - When you come to the Children's Center, say hello to everyone.
 - Write down your name on the guest book when you come and when you leave.
 - Make sure you wash your hands when you come to the Children's Center.
 - Do not drink or eat inside the Children's Center.
 - Do not bring something precious such as money, computer games, card collection and comic books, etc.
 - Return toys and other things to the original position after using.
 - **Use of the phone is not allowed at the Children's Center except in the event of emergency.**
 - Pre-school children must be always accompanied by their parents/guardians.

**The Children's Center is a space for everyone to play.
Please follow the instruction shown above so that everyone can enjoy.**

● To Parents and Guardians

- Basically, before they come to the Children's Center, children should go home once after school. If your child comes to the Children's Center directly from his/her school due to family reason, please tell your child what time you come and pick up or your child should be dismissed from the Children's Center alone in daylight at 5pm (4:30pm in winter).

● **After-School Childcare Club (Azuma-nishi jidou club)**

After-School Childcare Club (Azuma-nishi jidou club) is for children whose parents/guardians are not at home during the day due to work, etc.

Weekdays: From after-school hours (8am during school holidays) to 7pm
